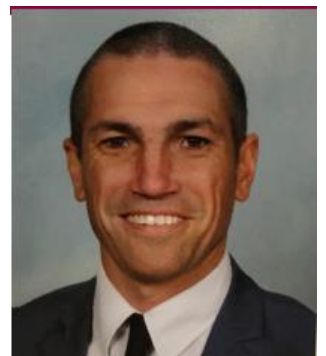
### Instructional Leader (English) - Marlee Buckley:
